

## **STUDENT RECOGNITION GRADES 1st-6th**

### **CHARACTER COUNTS AWARD**

Students may qualify for this award through any area of school endeavor and for contributions made to their class, school and/or community. The students selected are those who have best reflected the Bud Rank *Character Trait of the Month*, which is based on the six pillars of character in our Character Counts! Program. This award is given every month to two students per class in grades 1st-3rd and three students per class in grades 4th-6th. Students' names will appear in the Raven Reporter and they will receive a certificate and bumper sticker on the KRAV News.

### **PERFECT ATTENDANCE AWARD**

Perfect attendance will be recognized each semester for students who have no absences and less than five unexcused tardies. Students with perfect attendance for an entire year will receive a special certificate from Clovis Unified School District at the end of the 2nd semester.

### **ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD**

Students who have shown proficiency in both English Language Arts (Reading, Language and Writing) and Math for the semester will be recognized each semester. Students must demonstrate proficiency of 85% on each ELA and Math assessments, including math facts given during the semester. This award combines the English Language Arts and Math Award into one award, students who earn this award are not eligible for the ELA or Math Award.

### **ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS AWARD**

Students who have shown proficiency in ELA for the semester will be recognized each semester. Students must demonstrate proficiency of 85% on each ELA assessments during the semester.

### **MATH AWARD**

Students who have shown proficiency in Math for the semester will be recognized each semester. Students must demonstrate proficiency of 85% on each Math assessments including math facts given during the semester.

### **HONOR ROLL 4th-6th**

The Honor Roll is a means of giving recognition to students based on scholastic achievement. Honor Roll students are recognized each semester at an awards assembly. The qualification requirements for the Honor Roll are:

- ◆ No D's or F's on the report card.
- ◆ No N's or U's on the report card.
- ◆ The following grade point averages:

HIGH HONOR ROLL:	3.50 - 3.99
HONOR ROLL:	3.00 - 3.49
- ◆ The grade point averages are based on grades for: Reading, Mathematics, Language/Writing, Spelling, Science, and Social Science.
- ◆ The following grade points are used to calculate the grade point average: A=4.0, B=3.0, C=2.0, D=1.0

### **BUD RANK AWARD**

Presented each semester to one (1st-3rd) and two (4th-6th) students from each class who exemplify hard work, effort, and determination to succeed. Student will be presented a special Raven blue ribbon each semester at an awards assembly.

**RAVEN ATHLETIC AWARDS Grades 4th-6th**

Students receive a ribbon of participation for membership on any Bud Rank athletic team at the end of each sports season. Trophies will be presented to several students from each athletic team for individual recognition at the coach's discretion.

**BUD RANK BLOCK BR Grades 5th & 6th**

The Bud Rank Block BR Award is the highest award a student may earn. Students in grades 5-6 are eligible for this award. The criteria for earning this award reflect a broad base of participation, achievement and service. In order to earn the BLOCK BR, a student must accrue points in the following areas:
